Code of Ethics

SCU offers [multiple parking options](#) for visitors. Daily permits are available from the Main Gate kiosk, which is located at the University's main entrance at Palm Drive and El Camino Real, opposite the Santa Clara Transit Center.

We recommend using the [F - Leavey Center Lot](#). This lot is located immediately east of the Leavey Center and can be accessed via Accolti Way from El Camino Real.

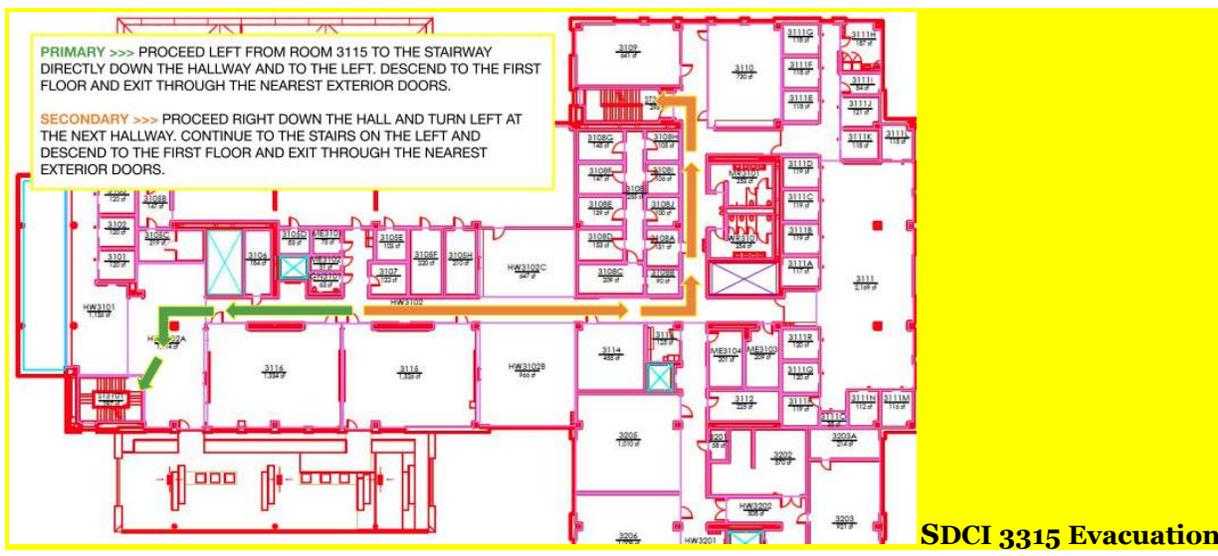
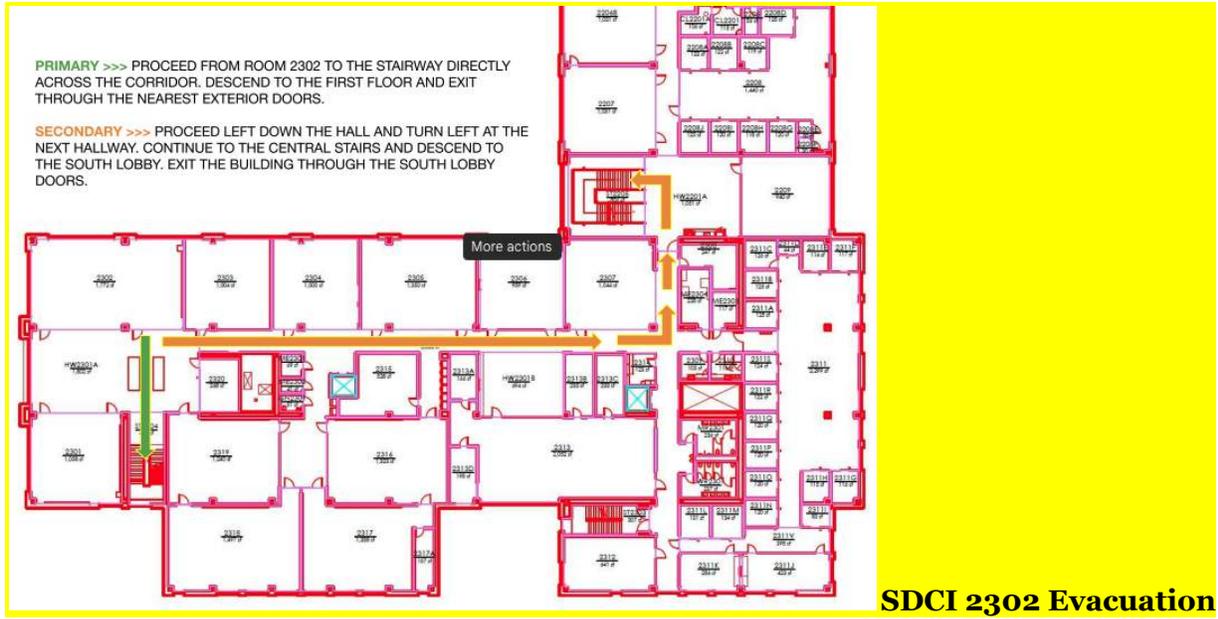
