Climate change threatens livelihoods with challenges such as irregular weather patterns severely impacting crops and livestock. However, sustainable farming practices such as crop diversification, conservation agriculture, and promoting drought-resistant crops and livestock breeds can better prepare African countries to design agriculture and food systems that withstand the effects of climate change.


